

Maths – (White Rose)

This term in Maths, our learning starts with:

Place Value

We will be beginning to identify 10s and 1s and how a 2 digit number, such as 14, had one ten and 4 ones.

Addition and subtraction (within 20)

Then we will be calculating additions and subtractions, using different representations such as dienes, cubes, bead strings, moving on to number lines.

Music

Through Charanga this term, we will appraise blues music and learn to sing 'In the groove' by BB King.

PSHE

Our Jigsaw theme this term is 'Dreams and Goals' – overcoming obstacles, setting goals and celebrating successes.

RE: Christianity

We are learning about Palm Sunday: reflecting on Jesus and friendship, and how it may have been difficult for him to show friendship. We explore this through a story called 'Say Hello' by Jack and Michael Foreman.

Spring 1 Term

Core Texts:



We are reading about Beegu's journey on Earth. We will explore adjectives, verbs and continue to practice using full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. Our second text will be The Odd Egg.

Writing outcomes: Our main outcome is an alien narrative story with our own alien main characters! Our main outcome for our second text will be an Egg Spotter's guide.

Curriculum Enhancer:

Our world, Our Community, Our future

Learning about the difference in locations around the world and how they compare to home



Geography



The children will learn that there are 7 continents and 5 oceans in the world. They will start to learn about the Equator and its role in creating hot and cold places. They will explore the North and South Pole, and who or what lives there compared to a hotter part of the world.

Art

We will be studying the works of Henri Matisse and Pablo Picasso, exploring their designs using the media of collage and paint mixing.

Science:

Animals including humans

This term we are focusing on the animal kingdom and how they are classified. We will also explore how some animals, live, eat and defend themselves.

PE

This term the children will be learning the skills of passing, using them in different games. They learn to pass a football with the inside of their foot, to pass a basketball with a bounce pass, and different sized balls in different game scenarios.

Computing

This term as part of our Teach Computing programme, we will be: Programming Beebots, combining them with geography, and moving the bot around a map.
