Reading Challenges for KS2

Read a book that was written in the year you were born	Read a newspaper or magazine	Read a book with over 200 pages
Read a biography	Read a graphic novel such as Tom Gates or Diary of a Wimpy Kid series	Read a book that someone from your family has recommended to you and review it using our school book review
Review a book that you've enjoyed and share it with your teacher	Read a book that's been made into a film, or watch a film based on a children's book	Read a mystery story like a Famous Five story
Play 20 questions about book characters; think of a character and see if your friends or family can guess who it is	Read a book with a one-word title	Read a poetry book and create your own poem based on something you've read – can you recite your poem to an audience from memory?
Read 2 books from the same author	Write a fact file about your favourite author	Read a non-fiction book and create a report based on what you've read
Visit your local library	Read a picture book and create your own narrative to match the pictures	Create a video of yourself reading to someone you know
