Cost of Living Support

Message from Reading Brighter Futures for Children

As part of the Council's Household Support Fund scheme this year, any Reading borough resident can now apply for support with the cost of living.

Priority will go to low-income households who are struggling financially. That primarily means those in receipt of low-income benefits or other related state benefits, and residents who are not in receipt of those benefits but have specific circumstances which have negatively impacted their overall cost of living, such as unexpected or increased expenditure.
